**Section 1 - Compatibility**

1.1 No Changes

2.1 Documentation

**Section 3 - Software Changes**

3.1 New Workbook - Enhancement

A “New Forecast Workbook” window has been added that prompts for all of the necessary information needed to create a new forecast workbook. This replaces the previous methodology which consisted of multiple separate prompts for different pieces of information.

3.2 Fetch & Post - Performance

When executing the Fetch or Post functions from Forecast Manager, the process will transition from one workbook to the next faster due resources that are being cached and shared from one workbook to the next.

3.3 File-Handle Leak - Fix

In previous versions, it was possible for one of the core components (Paris) to leak a file handle each time a workbook was fetched or posted. After 255 operations, this resulted in no file handles being available for subsequent operations. This has been resolved.
