## **Section 3 - Software Changes**

### **3.1 Send Email – New Feature**

Beginning with this release, whenever a report window is displayed (such as a recap for Determine Modifications or Perform Modifications), you may select the “Send Email” tool-bar button or select “File / Send Email”. This will start an email that has the displayed report attached as an html file that is zipped. The recipient address will prefill with the email address contained in General Settings.

### **3.2 Budget Settings**

In previous versions, the software would force a value to be entered for the Production Unit Category. The intention was to allow this field to be blank if needed. This has been resolved.

### **3.3 Budget Interface**

In previous versions, when a specific category was specified for the Estimated Production Units, the category was not being used. This has been resolved.

### **3.4 Subcontract CO Interface**

**3.4.1** In previous versions, it was possible to have adjusting change orders show up that had zero dollar amounts. This has been resolved.

**3.4.2** In previous versions, if a change was made to a Subcontract CO in Prolog (changing an amount or a budget code, or deleting an item) and if there were already five or more change orders for the contract, it was possible for Integrator to create the adjusting change order using the wrong change order number. This could have impacted an existing change order also. This has been resolved.

### **3.5 Cost Interface**

In previous versions, if there were no costs to send for a given project an error would be written to the recap. This has been resolved.
