Section 1 - Compatibility

1.1 Compatibility with Integrator database created by previous versions

The Integrator database structure has changed. After installing this version, when you will be notified that the database must be upgraded when you open a connection. The upgrade will be automatic.

Section 3 - Software Changes

3.1 IRUN – Unattended Execution

In older versions, the recap report was sent as an attached HTML file. In more recent versions it is included inside of a zip file. Since there is only one file and it is very small, the default behavior will be to no longer zip the file. If the user wishes to have the attachment zipped, a setting can be added to the IRUN.INI file:

3.2 Subcontract CO Interface

3.2.1 In the last update, criteria was added to ignore PCO Items that have no amount. This resulted in cases where a Subcontract CO in Prolog with no non-zero items would be compared to a Timberline Commitment CO (that has an amount of zero) and the software would still report that the commitment CO would be adjusted to zero. This warning no longer appears in this scenario. If the Subcontract CO in Prolog has no items and the amount of the commitment CO is non-zero then the warning will be displayed on the report.

3.2.2 An error in the validation logic for jobs,extras,cost codes and categories was corrected. Performance was also enhanced.

3.3 Contracts Interface

An error in the validation logic for jobs,extras,cost codes and categories was corrected. Performance was also enhanced.

3.4 Company Interface

When deriving the Timberline vendor ID from Prolog (or from the substitution table), if the "Use Capitals" box in Timberline is marked for the Vendor ID, the vendor ID will be forced to upper case.

3.5 Company ID Substitution Table

3.5.1 Added a new setting in the Options window: "Populate table from Prolog Companies using Short Name for Timberline Vendor ID". When checked, the user no longer has the ability to manually edit the substitution table. Instead the table is built using values from Prolog. The Timberline vendor ID is based on the Short Name field.

3.5.2 Fixed a problem with the "best fit" feature of the list window (used when selecting a company or vendor from the list).
