Section 1 - Compatibility

1.1 Compatibility with Integrator database created by previous versions

The Integrator database structure has changed. After installing this version, when you will be notified that the database must be upgraded when you open a connection. The upgrade will be automatic.

1.2 Compatibility with Prolog Manager 7.5 SP2 & Hotfix

Integrator version 2.81 and higher have been tested with Prolog Manager 7.50 SP2 with the addition of the HotFix.

1.3 Compatibility with Sage Timberline Office 9.3

Beginning with Integrator version 2.81.0007, Timberline 9.3 is supported. Previous versions of Integrator are not a compatible with Sage Timberline Office starting with version 9.3. Sage Timberline Office is scheduled to be released April 21, 2006 to new customers and to existing Service Managemnet customers. Sage Timberline Office version 9.4 is scheduled for release later in the year and will be released to all users.

Section 2 - Documentation

2.1 Documentation

Event 1 is in the process of developing help topics for each area of the product. At this time, help buttons appear in each window. Only some lead to a help topic at this time. Because the help topics are HTML pages on the Event 1 website, new topics will become available to you as they are posted (without the need to install a new version of the software).

Section 3 - Software Changes

3.1 Macros

Greater validation of Sage Timberline Office macros is now performed. This also includes additional logging that will aid in diagnosis of issues running macros.

3.2 Budgets Interface

Fixed problem where check-box value to select Job budgets was not being saved when interface direction was set to bi-directional.

3.3 Commitments Interface

- Added logic that checks for unit price of greater or equal to 1 million. In this case unit price will no longer be transferred and a warning message will be shown on the recap.
- Corrected problem that occurred when a substitution table is being used for Project & Job and the Commitment ID is being built from the combination of the Job Number and the Contract Number. Previously the job number segment was not utilizing the substitution table.

3.4 General Branding & Graphics

To align with new guidelines published by Sage Software, references to Timberline Office have been changed to Sage Timberline Office. This includes updates to text within the software as well as graphics.
